NEW DELHI : Prime Minister Narendra Modi said the new year had brought a “big achievement” with the development of not one but “two made-in-India” Covid vaccines. Speaking at the 75th jubilee of the National Physical Laboratory under the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, the Prime Minister said that every Indian was indebted to India’s “scientists and technicians”. The new year has brought with it another big achievement. India’s scientists have successfully developed not

just one, but two made-in-India Covid vaccines. In India, the world’s largest Covid vaccine programme is also about to begin. For this, the country is very proud of the contributions of its scientists. Every country person is indebted to all our scientists and technicians, Modi said. The PM said that because of the “sacrifice” of scientists, the country had a new respect for scientific institutions. “Today is the day to remember that time when our scientific organisations put night and day together for the fight against corona, to develop the vaccine. Along with CSIR, other organisations came together and faced all challenges together, and found solutions to new circumstances. Because of your sacrifice, the country a new feeling of awareness and respect for science institutions has been born,” he said. Modi said that in the past, India has been dependent on foreign standards for quality and measurement, but the country’s standards will decide the strength of the country, its products and its global standing. In this decade, India will have to give new heights to its standards.

LONDON: Christ the Redeemer is an Art Deco statue of Jesus Christ in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil, has been listed by World Book of Records, London as A symbol of Christianity across the world, the statue has also become a cultural icon of both Rio de Janeiro and Brazil and being one of the most visited spots with mythological and historic significance. Romanian sculptor Gheorghe Leonida fashioned the face. Constructed between 1922 and 1931, the statue is 30 metres (98 ft) high, excluding its 8-metre (26 ft) pedestal. The arms stretch 28 metres (92 ft) wide. The statue weighs 635 metric tons (625 long, 700 short tons), and is located at the peak of the 700-meter (2,300 ft) Corcovado mountain in the Tijuca Forest National Park overlooking the city of Rio de Janeiro. The United States Congress certified Joe Biden's election as the 46th President of the US after counting of Electoral College votes. Minutes after the US Congress' certification, President Donald Trump said there will be orderly transition on January 20. “Even though I totally disagree with the outcome of the election, and the facts bear me out, nevertheless there will be an orderly transition on January 20th,” Trump said in a statement issued by White House Deputy Chief of Staff Dan Scavino. “I have always said we would continue our fight to ensure that only legal votes were counted. While this represents the end of the greatest first term in presidential history, it's only the beginning of our fight to Make America Great Again!” Trump added. While today's certification exercise was supposed to be a mere formality as Biden had secured more than 270 Electoral College votes – required to clinch the presidency – the session was keenly watched because of incumbent President Trump's refusal to acknowledge the November 2020 election result and blocking a peaceful transfer of power.

Keeping up with the inspiration within alive, Shamsia, a 29 year old diva and artist has made her mark by making the biggest Mortier De Structure painting, which is made of marble dust and 100% polymer emulsion that adheres to any non oily absorbent surface and dries out slowly to a hardness of stone. Shamsia has worked hard all by herself for four days to complete the structure of painting and then coloured it. World Book of Records, London admires her passion and

meticulous effort and unbeatable patience to bring this project to an end and includes it in its India edition-2020. Shamsia's passion for art can be traced back to her young years around the age of 12, where she was exposed and introduced to art at Shantiniketan and from then on, it kept getting imbibed inside her like heart and soul and she kept on learning and later on took guidance of John Beckley- French Abstract Painter and chose this project as her forte to set a world record. She began by priming the surface and then built up the layers and left it to dry. Since it was an abstract painting, Shamsia made a note of not making it too vibrant and limited her colour choice to black, white, grey and beige. The motive was to reflect minimalism. The painting, if seen and observed closely speaks volumes about subtle undulations and calm atmosphere and also resonates the transition from dark to light and evokes the moon's reflection on the dark sea. The vibrations emanating from white light at night give the dark a mystical attribute. Shamsia's work has always been surrounded by the theme of contemporary art, which adds a sense of surprise and whims with minimum colours. culminates at a place called Bannimantap where the banni tree (*Prosopis spicigera*) is worshipped. According to a legend of the Mahabharata, banni tree was used by the Pandavas to hide their weapons during their one-year period of Agnatavasa (living life incognito). Before undertaking any warfare, the kings traditionally worshipped this tree to help them emerge victorious in the war. The Dasara festivities would culminate on the night of Vijayadashami with an event held in the grounds at Bannimantap called as Panjina Kavayattu (torch-light parade). 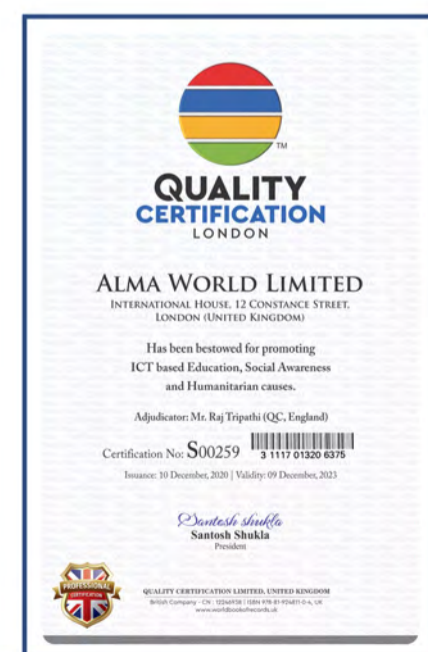
